




## Scrabble Tournament Schedule

**Eligibility:** All levels of players are welcome! Teams may register as Competitive or Social. We will attempt to match serious Scrabble players with more competitive teams, however, we cannot guarantee the level of everyone who registers.

**Teams:** Teams will consist of up to 4 people playing from a single letter tray, against another 4-member team playing from another single letter tray. Teams with less than 4 members may be matched with others to form a full team.

**Game Play:** All participants must follow official Scrabble rules. Tournament play will consist of three, 30-minute games. Each social team will have 3 minutes per turn, and each competitive team will have 2 minutes per turn.
